Tip of the Day Foreign Currency Exchange



The monetary unit for Korean money is "won." All Korean banks handle foreign currency exchange, especially the Foreign Exchange Bank (외환은행) that performs this transaction exclusively. There are also foreign currency exchange offices called 외환계 or 외환창구 at airports and major train stations. The rate of exchange will be posted there.

2. Banking in Korea

In everyday transactions such as shopping, the preferred mode of payment is still cash. Personal checks are not used much, because Korean banks offer such a convenient system of direct deposits, savings, loans, and pre-authorized debits that most people have their income go directly into their account. Running expenses, such as utilities, phone bills, rent, mortgage and loan payments are taken care of by their banks.

It is also interesting to know that the Korean Post Office functions as a banking institution, offering basic services such as savings, checking, and money orders.

3. Credit Cards

Credit cards such as Visa, Mastercard, and American Express are accepted in most stores, restaurants, hotels in large cities, and tourist spots. Besides these American originated cards, many other cards issued by big business firms like Lotte, 신세계, 미도과, LG, etc. are widely used in most metropolitan areas.




